

Brightness Layers

To Create Light Masks

Choose "Channels Panel"

Select RGB Channel

Click on "Load Channel as Selection"

Click on "Save Selection as Channel"

Rename the Channel as "Light 1"

Shift + Ctrl + Alt + Click on Thumbnail of Channel "Light 1"

Click on "Save Selection as Channel"

Rename the Channel as "Light 2"

Shift + Ctrl + Alt + Click on Thumbnail of Channel "Light 2"

Click on "Save Selection as Channel"

Rename the Channel as "Light 3"

Shift + Ctrl + Alt + Click on Thumbnail of Channel "Light 3"

Click on "Save Selection as Channel"

Rename the Channel as "Light 4"

To Create Dark Masks

Select RGB Channel

Click on "Load Channel as Selection"

Shift + Ctrl + i to invert selection

Click on "Save Selection as Channel"

Rename the Channel as "Dark 1"

Shift + Ctrl + Alt + Click on Thumbnail of Channel "Dark 1"

Click on "Save Selection as Channel"

Rename the Channel as "Dark 2"

Shift + Ctrl + Alt + Click on Thumbnail of Channel "Dark 2"

Click on "Save Selection as Channel"

Rename the Channel as "Dark 3"

Shift + Ctrl + Alt + Click on Thumbnail of Channel "Dark 3"

Click on "Save Selection as Channel"

Rename the Channel as "Dark 4"

To Create Mid Masks

Select RGB Channel

Ctrl + a to select all.

Ctrl + Alt + Click on "Light 1" thumbnail to subtract from selection

Ctrl + Alt + Click on "Dark 1" thumbnail to subtract from selection

Click on "Save Selection as Channel"

Rename the Channel as "Mid 1"

Select RGB Channel

Ctrl + a to select all.

Ctrl + Alt + Click on "Light 2" thumbnail to subtract from selection

Ctrl + Alt + Click on "Dark 2" thumbnail to subtract from selection

Click on "Save Selection as Channel"

Rename the Channel as "Mid 2"

Select RGB Channel

Ctrl + a to select all.

Ctrl + Alt + Click on "Light 3" thumbnail to subtract from selection

Ctrl + Alt + Click on "Dark 3" thumbnail to subtract from selection

Click on "Save Selection as Channel"

Rename the Channel as "Mid 3"

Select RGB Channel

Ctrl + a to select all.

Ctrl + Alt + Click on "Light 4" thumbnail to subtract from selection

Ctrl + Alt + Click on "Dark 4" thumbnail to subtract from selection

Click on "Save Selection as Channel"

Rename the Channel as "Mid 4"

To Create Effects Groups

Select "Layers" Palette

Click on "Create a New Group" three times to create three new groups

Rename these groups "Light", "Mid" and "Dark"

Select "Channels" palette

Click on the "Light 1" Channel

Click on "Load Channel as Selection"

Click on RGB

Select "Layers" palette

Click on "Light Group" to make it active.

Click on "Create New Fill or Adjustment Layer"

Choose "Brightness / Contrast"

Click "OK"

Rename the layer as "Light 1"

Select "Channels" palette

Click on the "Light 2" Channel

Click on "Load Channel as Selection"

Click on RGB

Select "Layers" palette

Repeat this for "Lights 3" and "Lights 4"

Click on "Light Group" to make it active.

Click on "Create New Fill or Adjustment Layer"

Choose "Brightness / Contrast"

Click "OK"

Rename the layer as "Light 2"

Repeat the above process for the "Mid" group and the "Dark" group

It is now a good idea to switch to the "Channels" palette and delete the twelve newly created channels. They take up a lot of space and are not needed anymore.
